## STEPS FOR TIGHTENING TOPTEX® WITH HANGING BALLAST

Correctly installed, hanging ballast ensures permanent tension for best protection.



**PREPARE FIXING TAPE** 

Cut fixing tape into 1 m pieces (15 m/roll = 15 pcs)



THE **BAGS** 

Connect carabiner to fibre pocket of the bag or its handle



**PREPARE FULL FIXING** 

Feed fixing tape through carahiner



**ATTACH TAPE BALLAST** 

Let the bag stand on the ground

THE

**AND** 

while holding the «V» shaped fixing tape in both hands, then lift and attach to the cover









#### DETAILS FOR POSITIONING

#### Be aware that bales will settle over time

- •Always place the ballast on a bale, never in the gap between two bales.
- •Obey lifting height with 10-20cm distance between the bag and the ground.
- •Avoid horizontal waves or folds on the surface of the cover.
- •Lift and place the bag no higher than the center line of the bale.

This will prevent pressure points on the bale.

### **REPEAT** THE PROCESS

The distance between the bags shall be 2 to 4 meters depending on the wind conditions; secure overlaps seperately
